## 2022 Fellowship Course of the Australian Institute of Dermatology

To be eligible to take the Fellowship course you have to have successfully completed the Institute's Membership and Advanced Membership courses or equivalent overseas Dermatology Diplomas and Advanced Surgical courses from the Skin Cancer College Australia or University of Queensland. The 2022 Fellowship course will be run over 2 semesters of 14 weeks each with 7 modules in each semester. Each module will cover in week 1 Clinical cases, Cosmetic dermatology, Dermatopathology, and Treatment Pharmacology plus some Weekly test images to go over. There are also module assessment questions that you should note your answers to when reading the module. These do not have to be formally submitted.

In week 2 of each module we cover DermSurgery, Tumour Dermatopathology, Dermatoscopy and Laboratory Medicine/Investigations.

There are Preview videos for each module and videos of formal answers to the Assessment questions for each module.

You will be required to submit 10 cases to the VCM in <u>www.dermconsult.com.au</u> during the course.

Semester 1 will run from 2<sup>nd</sup> Feb through the 9<sup>th</sup> May and from 10<sup>th</sup> June until the 14<sup>th</sup> September approximately. There will be exams at the end of each Semester. See <u>www.aideducational.com</u> under Courses for further details.

Preceding each module there will be a discussion of cases submitted to the VCM and interesting cases submitted to the VCMs of the other Institute courses as well as cases from Specialist Dermatology practice.

The Fellowship of the Australian Institute of Dermatology does not allow you to practice as a Specialist Dermatologist in Australia under Medicare . You need to be a Fellow of the Australasian College of Dermatologists to do this. However it does equip you to operate an independent dermatology practice providing a very high standard of care. This is especially useful in Rural or outer metropolitan areas where access to a Specialist Dermatologist is difficult.

The course fees for 2022 will be \$1750 if paid by the 1st Dec 2021 and \$2000 if paid after that date.
